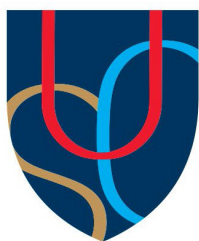

University Senior College 20 Years Anniversary Scholarship for Years 10, 11 or 12 entry in 2024 and is available for new and current students. The University Senior College 20 Years Anniversary Scholarship is available to students who demonstrate the ability to significantly contribute to University Senior College in a range of areas. Scholarship applicants are required to submit documentation indicating ability in a minimum of three of the following areas:

- Academic
- Leadership
- Public Speaking
- Social Justice

This is a once off Scholarship offering to signify the College's 20 Years Anniversary and the funds have been generously donated by members of the University Senior College community.

As part of the application process, all candidates will have an interview with the Principal or the Dean of Student Experience. All new students who submit a scholarship application are also required to sit a general ability test prior to the interview.

EXPECTATION

The continuation of the scholarship is subject to the recipient making very good academic progress, contributing to the life of the College, displaying conduct of a high standard and an annual review process including the Principal and Dean of Student Experience. Each recipient will be expected to provide feedback to the Principal about the impact of the scholarship. The family will be invited to participate in occasional events and activities that recognise and give thanks to the community of donors.

HOW TO APPLY

- Complete the online scholarship application form
- Upload copies of all relevant documentation
- Payment of Scholarship Application Fee \$100 (new students only)

Please Note: If you are applying for multiple scholarships, only one application fee payment is required.

All applications must be submitted through our online application process which can be accessed on our website within our scholarship categories. You will receive an email confirmation of application receipt. Refer to the checklist to ensure you have the correct documentation ready to submit with your application.

All new students who submit a scholarship application are required to sit a general ability test and have an enrolment interview. The Enrolment Officer will inform you of the outcome of the Scholarship you applied for when known.

CHECKLIST

For the student to be considered for a scholarship, please ensure all the requested documents are uploaded:

- ☐ A cover letter written by the student, detailing their reasons for seeking a Year 10, 11 or 12 20 Year Anniversary Scholarship and how they would embrace the learning opportunities available at University Senior College.
- ☐ A cover letter from the student's parents/guardians, detailing their reasons for seeking a Year 10, 11 or 12 20 Year Anniversary Scholarship.
- ☐ A copy of the two most recent semester reports.
- ☐ Copies of the Student's Year 9 national Assessment Program Literacy and Numeracy Test (NAPLAN) results.
- ☐ References from teacher, community leader, mentor and/or coach (Required for new students only).
- ☐ Evidence of financial circumstances, if the applicant wishes these to be taken into consideration.
- ☐ Any other relevant documents that will support the application.
